**Open speaker meetings**— open to Alcoholics and non-Alcoholics (attendance at an open A.A. meeting is the

best way to learn what A.A. is, what it does, and what it does not do.) At speaker meetings, A.A. members "tell their stories." They describe their experiences with alcohol, how they came to A.A., and how their lives have changed as a result of Alcoholics Anonymous.

... <u>Open discussion meetings</u> one member speaks briefly about his or her drinking experience, and then leads a discussion on A.A. recovery or any drinking-related problem anyone brings up (Closed meetings are for A.A.s or anyone who may have a drinking problem.)

<u>discussion meetings</u> — conducted just as open discussions are, but for alcoholics or prospective AA.s only.

<u>meetings (usually closed)</u> discussion of one of the Twelve Steps of Alcoholics Anonymous.
