The Guideline changes listed below are based on Motions passed at our previous Area Assembly. These updates will be presented at the Area 74 Assembly on **April 27, 2019** – Sat 8:30 a.m., at Reiter Center, 1858 S. Michigan St, Three Lakes, WI. Paper copies of these changes will be available at the April Assembly.

#### Structure and Guidelines Committee proposed updates to current v 05-2018.

**Now and Then Motion**: The Area 74 Now and Then, will use electronic publication for the monthly issues produced. Groups with no ability to receive an electronic copy may opt in to receive a printed hard copy via US Postal Service paid for by group contributions received by Area 74. Any other entity or person may receive a printed hard copy provided they pay for the cost of production and postage in advance.

#### Draft of placement

Article IV Section 7.00 The Newsletter is entitled the "Now and Then". The newsletter is the medium for communication of Area 74 business. Published monthly, the editorial staff are responsible for determining the content of each issue. However, materials submitted by any Area Officer will be printed, when provided in a timely manner. The editorial staff shall request appropriate funding from the Finance Committee when necessary to meet the costs of publication.

The Area 74 Now and Then, will use electronic publication for the monthly issues produced. Groups with no ability to receive an electronic copy may opt in to receive a printed hard copy via US Postal Service paid for by group contributions received by Area 74. Any other entity or person may receive a printed hard copy provided they pay for the cost of production and postage in advance.

#### NOW & THEN CONVERSION COMMITTEE REPORT

Purpose of Now and Then Conversion Committee

To complete conversion from US Postal Service to primarily digital distribution

Assist Co-Editors with creating guidelines for publication in new format

Figure out best ways to inform groups/members of new distribution

The committee has met several times and has been working on the following items:

- 1. Price/cost of printing/mail using US Postal Service cost of monthly issue to be \$25 for 12 mos.
- 2. What methods is the N&T going to utilize to 'promote' the changeover -- we have sent a mailing to registered groups with good mailing addresses and posted an announcement on Area 74 website. Seek assistance from Area Committee members, GSRs, and AA members to make announcements, The committee is still trying to come up with other ideas for 'marketing'
- 3. What is the procedure(s) for groups WITH NO MEANS TO RECEIVE N&T BY ELECTRONIC DELIVERY to opt in to receive a hard copy? The committee has determined to send hard copies to those groups that have requested them until the Area74 Assembly approves parameters for how groups can qualify for hard copy mailing. The committee is going to make recommendations but the Assembly will have the final say.
- 4. **Build the email list** Co-Editor & Area 74 Registrar have been collaborating. List is up to about 760 as of publication of the Feb 2019 issue. The database has about 250 group emails, N&T has 500 email other than the registered groups' contacts.
- **5. Decide on new email server to handle larger mailings** Committee chose Gmail for Business with a cost of \$11 month for up to 2000 emails daily. Still developing the utilization of the service.
- 6. How can we reach groups in 'dark' districts with no active DCMs? Currently researching which districts are under represented and how we can reach groups in those districts. The Area Chair has been requested by the committee to give his input and help develop communication links with DCMs
- 7. What parameters do we need to establish for materials to include in future issues and what is going to be included in hard copies vs digital versions? Discussion starting and we are open to suggestions from the Area 74 membership

The committee has 7 members ranging from an AA member familiar with Area 74, Area Committee members (S & G committee member, DCMs, N&T Co-Editor) and a couple other experienced trusted servants who serve other positions besides as AC members. It is a good mix and everyone is participating in our weekly calls and taking on tasks to keep moving forward. Jeff C. N & T Co-Editor


