Report from the Area 74 Ad Hoc committee on “Where do we go from here’

The purpose of the committee was to discuss options on how Area 74 was going to have service meetings in the future. The Committee met on 10-11-2021 at 700 pm CST via Zoom and 10-18-2021 700 pm CST. The Committee discussed and reviewed the following discussion items:

- 1) The cost of purchasing equipment for Hybrid style meeting
- 2) Creating a new service position for Hybrid style meeting
- 3) Reviewed the attendance at service meetings since the Pandemic
- 4) The Delegate sent out a request for info on Hybrid meeting formats to the 93 Delegate Areas.

There were 6 responses requesting to share any information received from that request. Alaska sent their criteria on equipment needs and logistic to make a Hybrid style meeting possible or the possibility of outsourcing the processing.

The Committee concluded that funding the purchase of equipment and creating a service position could be accomplished in a relatively short time frame.

The Delegate then mentioned she sent out a request for information about meeting formats and there was a limited response to the inquiry.

The discussion then turned to the meeting attendance since the initiation of the Hybrid style meeting.

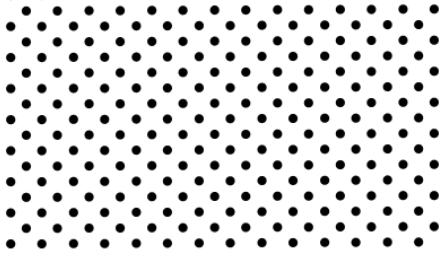
It was concluded that the Hybrid style meeting did not increase participation even though it was more convenient to attend.

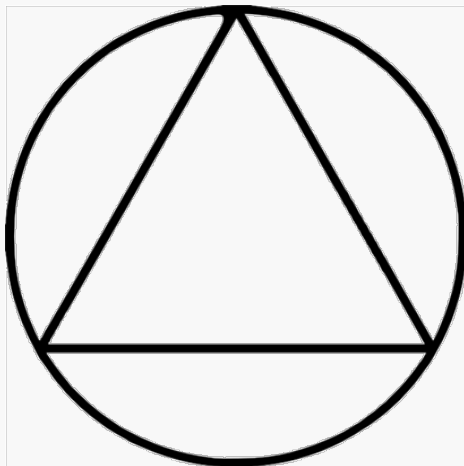
