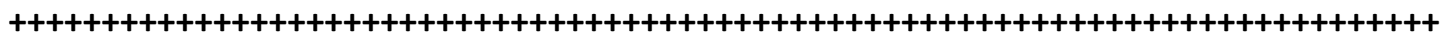

Service is the secret?

“Just keep busy”

If Bill Wilson or Dr. Bob were to walk into an AA meeting today, and then observe a present-day AA member for a period of time, both gentlemen would probably be dumbfounded. What they would see is that AA has succumbed to the old formula for not drinking, one that every newcomer tries: “Just keep busy.”

Our early Delegates only attended one G.S. Conference every 2 years; it was a 4-day weekend. Area Assemblies were the same frequency. Now we have 4 or 5 Assemblies every year and a Conference every year! Bill & Bob would be shocked that the GSR is not allowed to vote on the Conference Agenda items, that it is now the DCM's job... and we wonder why GSRs don't come to the Assemblies. The original DCM's responsibility was only as a contact for the Delegate and the District. And they certainly didn't try to juggle a hundred or more Conference Agenda items... more like a dozen!

Benjamin Franklin may have summarized our present condition best: “Never confuse Motion with Action.”

Our Co-founders would probably be shocked to find that most AA members today were never brought through the 12 Steps by another member, at no cost to them, but rather by for-profit treatment centers and paid counselors with their “professional” take on the AA program. It is a truism that most current AA members have never brought anyone through the 12 Steps -- despite repeated warnings that we not only need to do this to stay sober, but it is our obligation to share what we have found - the joy of our sobriety. Too few members today know that joy or have sufficient understanding of our program to pass it on.

Our Service Legacy has done much to make AA what it is today. Our Area 74 Conferences have in the past had many treatment center counselors, clergy, and psychiatrists as the main speakers. After Bill died all bets were off, and they still are. Our GSO manager is paid very well. More and more literature is added every year; we have a pamphlet for everything, about a third of GSO's income comes from their direct solicitation - - bypassing any control by our AA groups' “power of the purse.” Our Trustees control the agenda of the Conference, and the GSB members are sworn to secrecy. Something's very broke in AA and we seem to be afraid to talk about it. If Bill or Dr. Bob were here today, they would not hesitate to point this out!

New York is not listening... maybe it is time for Area 74 to boycott the 2023 General Service Conference?

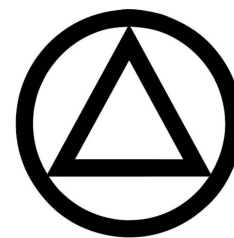
