### Delegate's Corner

Greetings Area 74,

Since mid-April I have been reviewing the background material for the General Service Conference, talking with other Delegates, talking with our East Central Regional Trustee, and talking with other members of Area 74 that have contacted me with concerns over the recent resignations. There was one more "question and answer" session with the entire voting membership on 4-13-23. I will include what I learned from that session in my report back to the Assembly in Green Bay. My feeling is, that as a Conference, we will be discussing the resignations and the concerns behind them. My hope is that the resignation topic does not dominate the entire conference, but that is not in my control.

I want to thank everyone that participated in the April Assembly in Three Lakes. The effort put forth to digest the background material, discuss the agenda items, and arrive at some form of a group consensus, is what makes AA special in this controversial world.

My wife and I spent a few days together in upstate New York before the 73<sup>rd</sup> General Service Conference. We rented a car to do some sightseeing. While driving in New York, I made a mistake in choosing which lane I needed to be in and was trying to change lanes before entering an on-ramp to the interstate, I had my turn signal on, and was slowly trying to merge. In my review mirror I could tell the driver behind me was yelling at me and using hand gestures to encourage me to speed up. The driver in the next lane was nice enough to give me the space so I could change lanes. Then the driver behind me zoomed past me, passed three other cars, cut off another car, and then entered the same on-ramp I was entering. My wife and I both looked at each other in surprise and then we burst out laughing.

If this had been a "before AA" situation, I would have been extremely upset and it may have turned into a road rage incident (which then would have led to you reading about me in the paper).

In AA I have learned an entirely different way of looking at life. The problems and incidents that used to upset me are few and far between. In the Big Book there is a quote on page 84 that I have taken to heart, "Love and tolerance of others is our code." If we apply that principle in our lives, the actions of others will have little or no effect on my serenity. Whether it is driving on the interstate or in a conference room in New York.

I will be returning to Area 74 on 5-1-23. After reviewing my notes, I will write my report for the 73<sup>rd</sup> GSC, which will be presented in Green Bay at the next Assembly. Hope to see you then.

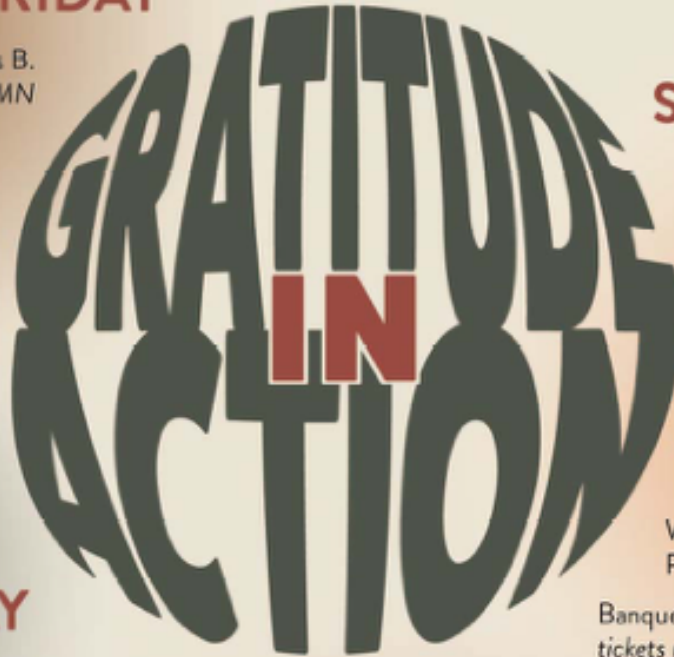

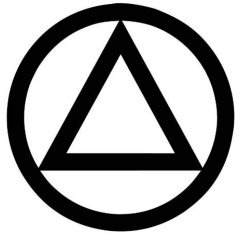
